Stickout Length = 0.5" (or $\underline{4}$ increments x 1/8") = 04Use 00 for no clearance hole. Stickout Length = 1.5" (or $\underline{12}$ increments x 1/8") = $\underline{12}$ (ØD) Weld Face Diameter (measured in number of 1/8" increments) Weld Face Diameter = 0.375" (or $\underline{3}$ increments x 1/8") = 03Weld Face Diameter = 1" (or $\underline{8}$ increments x 1/8") = 08
